## **8. INFORMATION ABOUT HIGHER EDUCATION IN POLAND**

### **8.1 Criterion for access to higher education**

The total duration of education until the completion of the school providing for the opportunity to take the matriculation examination is 12–15 years. After passing the matriculation examination, graduates receive a secondary school-leaving certificate allowing them to apply for admission to a university.

### **8.2 Higher education**

The principles of the functioning of higher education are specified in the Act of 20 July 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 85, as amended).

Public universities are created by the state body. Studies at universities are conducted as first-cycle studies, second-cycle studies or uniform master's studies. The studies may be conducted as full-time studies or part-time studies.

First-cycle full-time studies last at least 6 semesters, and if the curriculum includes learning outcomes to obtain engineering competences, - at least 7 semesters. Second-cycle full-time studies last from 3 to 5 semesters. Full-time uniform master's studies last from 9 to 12 semesters.

Part-time studies may take longer than equivalent full-time studies.

Qualifications obtained as a result of graduation in higher education are attributed to the level of the Polish Qualification Framework defined in the Act of 22 December 2015 on the Integrated Qualification System (Journal of Laws of 2018 item 2153, as amended).

The diploma of completion of first-cycle studies confirms the awarding of full qualifications at level 6 of the Polish Qualifications Framework.

The diploma of completion of the second-cycle studies and the diploma of completion of uniform master's studies

confirm the granting of full qualifications at level 7 of the Polish Qualifications Framework.

### **8.3 Titles awarded to graduates:**

- 1) bachelor (licencjat), engineer (inżynier) and equivalent: architect engineer (architekt inżynier), fire engineer (inżynier pożarnictwa), bachelor of nursing (licencjat pielęgniarstwa), bachelor of midwifery (licencjat położnictwa) – granted to graduates of first-cycle studies,
- 2) Master's degree (magister), Master's degree and equivalent:
  - a) Master's degree in architecture engineering (magister inżynier architekt), Master's degree in fire safety engineering (magister inżynier pożarnictwa), Master's degree in nursing (magister pielęgniarstwa), Master's degree in midwifery (magister położnictwa)- awarded to graduates of the second-cycle studies,
  - b) doctor (lekarz), dentist (lekarz dentysta), veterinary surgeon (lekarz weterynarii), Master's degree in pharmacy (magister farmacji), Master's degree in architecture (magister inżynier architekt) - awarded to graduates of uniform master's studies.

### **8.4 Credit points ECTS**

In order to obtain a diploma of completion of first-cycle studies, the student is required to obtain at least 180 ECTS, second-cycle studies - at least 90 ECTS, uniform master's studies - at least 300 ECTS, if they last 9 or 10 semesters or at least 360 ECTS credit points if they last 11 or 12 semesters.
